

**RESOLUTION NO. 991**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REGULATION FOR USE OF HOLIDAY DECORATIVE LIGHTING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the need to regulate the use of Holiday Decorative Lighting, and;

**WHEREAS**, Holiday Decorative Lighting is prohibited to be in place or in use on any commercial structure as a permanent display, and;

**WHEREAS**, the use of Holiday Decorative Lighting shall be established as only during the Winter Holiday Season beginning the third Monday in November and ending the second Friday in January for a period not to exceed 60 days.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Jacksonville hereby adopts this Resolution for the use of Holiday Decorative Lighting. Violation of this Resolution will be declared a nuisance.
